GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES

German as a Foreign Language – Courses for ERASMUS and other exchange students

The University's Language Center offers the following courses in German as a Foreign Language:

The tuition fee for courses 1 and/or 2 is **€300 per semester**.

1	Intensive German Course including excursion	A1 (beginners) to C1b (advanced)	Weekdays daily 8.15 – 11.45 (13:30) Total 400 hours	3 x 5 = 15 CPs
2	Lecture course: "German Grammar" without presentation with presentation	C1 upward	2 hours per week	2 CPs 3-4 CPs

You will take a placement test before beginning the course. This will indicate your level of proficiency in German, and you will be allocated to a course accordingly.
